BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: Private Jeremy P. Faulkner, 23, of Griffin, Georgia,

honorably served our country in the United States Army; and

WHEREAS: Private Faulkner made the ultimate sacrifice on March 29

after his unit (2nd Battalion, 327th Infantry Regiment, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division) was attacked

in Konar province, Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Private Faulkner's service

and sacrifice by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and grounds to half-staff on the day of his

interment.

Now, therefore, in honor and as a mark of respect for the memory of Private Jeremy P. Faulkner,

PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR

OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

Ordered: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of

Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and grounds on Saturday, April 9, 2011, the day of his

funeral, until sunset.
