## A PROCLAMATION

### THE SOCIETY OF COLONIAL WARS DAYS

WHEREAS: Since its establishment in 1893, the Society of Colonial Wars has worked to provide celebrations commemorating the colonial history of this nation from the settlement of Jamestown in 1607 through the Battle of Lexington in 1775; and

WHEREAS: Founded to perpetuate the memory of those events and individuals who assisted in the establishment, defense and preservation of the American Colonies, the Society of Colonial Wars seeks to collect and safeguard manuscripts, relics and records, hold suitable commemorations and erect memorials, promoting patriotism and inspiring respect for our founding fathers who secured the freedoms we cherish; and

WHEREAS: This year, members from across the nation will be meeting in Georgia for the Society of Colonial Wars 103<sup>rd</sup> General Council; now

THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 27, 2011, as SOCIETY OF COLONIAL WARS DAYS in Georgia and encourage all Georgians to recognize the Society of Colonial Wars and its efforts to help preserve the colonial history of our great nation.
