EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On August 23, 2012, sixteen year old Hannah Truelove was reported missing and on August 24, 2012, Hannah was found murdered in a wooded area near the apartment complex where she lived; and

WHEREAS: The Hall County Sheriff's Office, with the assistance of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, conducted an investigation but have been unable to generate any solid leads; and

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for the murder of Hannah Truelove.
