EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exists at Valdosta State University, Lowndes County,

Valdosta, Georgia, a building located at 107 West Jane Street (#0107), (the

"Building"); and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents' Policy 9.9.3.3. DEMOLITION authorizes the

Chancellor or Vice Chancellor for Facilities to declare buildings, structures and other improvements no longer advantageously useful to the University

System of Georgia. Such building is included within this policy; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined by Mr. Jim James, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of

the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that said Building can no longer be advantageously used by Valdosta State University or the

University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of the

STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby

authorized to demolish and remove the Building from Valdosta State

University, Lowndes County, Valdosta, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of Valdosta State University, Lowndes County,

Valdosta, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish said Building and to have all building materials removed from the premises; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
