EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND GROUNDS, GOVERNOR'S MANSION,
AND ALL GSP POSTS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: On Tuesday, February 7, 2017, Georgia State Trooper SFC Tony Henry succumbed to injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident on December 3, 2016; and

WHEREAS: SFC Henry was a dedicated public servant having served for more than six years as an integral, trusted, and loved member of the Governor's Executive Security Detail. His commitment to public safety was evidenced by his 17 year career with the Georgia State Patrol, and his previous service with the Covington and Conyers Police Departments; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize the passing of SFC Tony Henry and to honor his commitment to serve the citizens of the state of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF GEORGIA STATE TROOPER SFC TONY HENRY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and flag of the Great State of Georgia be flown at half-staff starting at sunrise on Friday, February 10, 2017, on the State Capitol building and grounds, the Georgia Governor's Mansion, and all GSP Posts throughout Georgia until sunset on Saturday, February 11, 2017, the day of SFC Henry's interment.
