EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: The Honorable Bob Bryant, former District 162 representative in the Georgia House of Representatives, passed away on Thursday, February 25, 2016; and

WHEREAS: Having served for more than 12 years in the Georgia House of Representatives, Mr. Bryant was a dedicated public servant whose civic-minded spirit was evidenced throughout his entire professional life beginning with his role as a city of Savannah employee and 10 years of service in the Army; and

WHEREAS: Representative Bryant's civic duties ranged from his many years of service as the Garden City Council Honorary Councilman and two terms as Mayor Pro-Tem, to his involvement in numerous city organizations; and

WHEREAS: A true advocate for the citizens of Georgia, it is fitting and proper to remember and honor Representative Bryant for his service to our state.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND MEMORY OF THE HONORABLE BOB BRYANT, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and grounds on Saturday, March 5, 2016, the day of Representative Bryant's interment, until sunset.
