EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Early language development and literacy are vitally important to

ensuring successful educational opportunities for Georgia's youth;

and

WHEREAS: It is especially critical for children from birth to eight years of age to

develop strong literacy and language skills to effectuate positive

learning outcomes that will last a lifetime; and

WHEREAS: Families and teachers in child care centers, pre-schools, and K-3

classrooms, as well as those involved in early childhood education programs in universities and technical colleges would benefit from

research-based practices and community engagement.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Georgia Center for Early Language and Literacy (the

"Center") is hereby established and a governing board, appointed by the Governor, is hereby created to employ and advise the

Executive Director of the Center.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the Georgia Center for Early Language and Literacy will be

housed at Georgia College and State University ("GCSU") with GCSU providing appropriate space, IT, and secretarial support for

the Center.
