BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

- WHEREAS:** Pfc. Johnathon F. Davis, 20, of Griffin, Georgia, honorably served our country in the United States Army; and
- WHEREAS:** Pfc. Davis made the ultimate sacrifice on March 29 after becoming involved in enemy small arms fire in the Kandahar province of Afghanistan; and
- WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Pfc. Davis' service and sacrifice by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and grounds to half-staff on the day of his interment.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF PFC. JOHNATHON F. DAVIS, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and grounds on Saturday, April 7, 2012, the day of his funeral, until sunset.
