BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

On April 29, 2017, 1ST Lieutenant Weston Cecil Lee was tragically killed while WHEREAS:

on patrol outside of Mosul, Iraq; and

1ST Lt. Weston Lee, 25, of Bluffton, Georgia, honorably served our country as a WHEREAS:

U.S. Army paratrooper. He was a member of the 82nd Airborne Division and

was serving as an infantry officer; and

1ST Lt. Lee's exceptional service to our country was evidenced by earning the WHEREAS:

> National Defense Service Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Ranger Tab, the Parachutist Badge, and the Army Service Ribbon. And posthumously being awarded the Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart, and the

Meritorious Service Medal: and
