EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On April 26, 2017, Ms. Ruth Barr, Alderman-at-Large of the City of Hapeville, was convicted of a felony; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6.1(c)(1), there being no general or local law, ordinance, or resolution governing the appointment of a replacement officer, the Governor is authorized to appoint, for the duration of the suspension, a replacement for the Alderman-at-Large.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6.1(c)(1), Mr. Mike Rast is hereby appointed to fill the temporary vacancy in the office of Alderman-at-Large pending the final disposition of the conviction of Ms. Ruth Barr or until the expiration of her term of office, whichever occurs first.
