## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to 6.4461 acres of improved real property (the

"Property") by virtue of order of condemnation (Civil Action File No. 96-8618-9) dated September 16, 1996, filed in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court in

DeKalb County; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Corrections (the "Department")

and was acquired as part of the Fleet Management Facility; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with an approximate 768 square foot structure (BLLIP)

ID #714), an approximate 384 square foot structure (BLLIP ID #715), and an approximate 40 square foot shed (BLLIP ID #720) (collectively, the "Structures"), as shown in that aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated

herein by reference; and

WHEREAS: Said Structures are identified by the Department to be in disrepair, have been

abandoned, contain no salvageable equipment of value, and have been identified as

hazardous in their present state; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Corrections on May 4, 2017, resolved to recommend the removal of the

Structures and requested that the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the

Structures as in the best interest of the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**Ordered:** The Department of Corrections is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the

razing, demolition and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions

which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.
