EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Pursuant to 44 C.F.R. § 75.1 et seq., states must purchase flood insurance for all

state owned buildings located in certain flood prone areas in order to be eligible to

receive Federal disaster assistance for flood-related losses; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to 44 C.F.R. § 75.10, a state may be exempt from the requirement to

purchase flood insurance if the state establishes a plan of self-insurance determined by the Federal Insurance Administrator to meet or exceed those standards set forth

in 44 C.F.R. § 75.11; and

WHEREAS: 44 C.F.R. § 75.11 (a)(7) requires the establishment of flood plain management

regulations setting forth standards for State owned properties which satisfy the

criteria set forth in 44 C.F.R. § 60.3, 60.4 and 60.5.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED:

1. All new construction or substantial improvements of state owned buildings

shall comply with 44 C.F.R. § 60.3, 60.4, and 60.5.

2. The Georgia State Financing and Investment Commission shall issue permits for all construction or substantial improvements of state owned buildings in flood prone, mudslide prone, and flood-related erosion prone areas in

compliance with 44 C.F.R. § 60.3, 60.4, and 60.5.

3. All state agencies, departments, commissions, and authorities constructing new buildings or substantial improvements of existing buildings located on state owned property in flood prone, mudslide prone, or erosion prone areas shall apply to the Georgia State Financing and Investment Commission for a

construction permit prior to the commencement of construction.
