EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

H.B. 636 was passed by the Georgia General Assembly during the

2011-2012 Regular Session and signed into law on April 16, 2012;

and

WHEREAS:

H.B. 636 provided for the incorporation of the City of Brookhaven

in DeKalb County if approved by a referendum; and

WHEREAS:

Pursuant to H.B. 636 the proposed City of Brookhaven was

submitted to qualified voters for approval or rejection by

referendum on July 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS:

54.61% of the voters approved the incorporation of the City of

Brookhaven; and

WHEREAS:

Pursuant to Section 6.05 of H.B. 636 and O.C.G.A. § 36-31-8(g), I

am required to appoint five persons to the Governor's Commission

on Brookhaven; and

WHEREAS:

The Governor's Commission on Brookhaven shall include a

chairperson and at least one representative from each council

district.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME

AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

That the District 2 representative on the Governor's Commission on Brookhaven is Todd Lantier of 1417 Wilford Drive NE, Atlanta, Georgia 30319.

That the District 3 representative on the Governor's Commission on Brookhaven is Jed Beardsley of 1081 Hunters Brook Court, Atlanta, Georgia 30319.

That the District 4 representative on the Governor's Commission on Brookhaven is Kim Gökçe of 1955 Fairway Circle NE, Atlanta, Georgia 30319.
