EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exists a dispute over the location of a boundary

between Macon County and Taylor County; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-3-20, et. seg., the Clerk of Superior Court

of Macon County has requested the appointment of an independent surveyor to clearly define a portion of the boundary between said

counties; and

WHEREAS: The Secretary of State will negotiate with the appointed surveyor a

rate for services to be rendered by the surveyor. The cost of services rendered by the surveyor will be split between Macon County and

Taylor County.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Mr. Steve Coleman with Steve Coleman & Associates, Inc. Land

Surveyors be appointed as the surveyor to define the boundary line

between Macon County and Taylor County.
