## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Mr. Thomas L. Witts, Mayor of the City of Snellville, was indicted on September 7,

2017, on 19 counts of False Statements and Writings, Concealment of Facts, and Fraudulent Documents in Matters Within Jurisdiction of State or Political Subdivision; 19 counts of False Swearing; 2 counts of Violation of Oath by Public Officer; 4 counts of Sale of Property to Political Subdivision by Officer or Employee; 17 counts of Theft by Conversion; and 5 counts of Evasion of Income

Tax. Penalty. Interest, or Other Amount in Excess of \$3,000.00; and

**WHEREAS:** The indictment was transmitted to the Office of the Governor pursuant to O.C.G.A.

§ 45-5-6(b), and the certified copy was received on September 22, 2017; and

WHEREAS: On October 10, 2017, a review commission composed of Attorney General Chris

Carr, Mayor Vanessa Fleisch of the City of Peachtree City, and Mayor Steve Tumlin of the City of Marietta was appointed to determine whether the indictment related to or adversely affected the administration of the office of Mayor by Mr. Witts; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(e), Mr. Witts has voluntarily authorized the

Governor to suspend him from the office of Mayor of the City of Snellville; and

WHEREAS: After reviewing the indictment and the letter from Mr. Witts, the commission

recommended that Mayor Witts be suspended from office pursuant to the

provisions of O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**ORDERED:** That Mr. Thomas L. Witts, Mayor of the City of Snellville, is hereby suspended from

office immediately and without further action pending the final disposition of the case or until expiration of his term of office, whichever occurs first, as provided in

O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(c).
