BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN GWINNETT COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: On Saturday, October 20, 2018, Gwinnett County Police Officer

Antwan Toney, 30, was tragically killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS: Officer Toney honorably served the citizens of Gwinnett County for

three years; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Toney's service to

Gwinnett County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on

the State Capitol building and in Gwinnett County to half-staff.

be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Gwinnett

County on Wednesday, October 24, 2018.
