



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 557 acres of real property (the "Property"), known as the Spirit Creek Educational Forest, located in Richmond County; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Forestry Commission ("GFC") by way of transfer from the Georgia Department of Human Resources, by Executive Order signed by the Governor on February 20, 1984, and was acquired by GFC for timber management, conservation, and protection of the property as forest land; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with the old Spirit Creek Office (BLLIP ID # 36000) and a storage building known as "Chicken House #54" (BLLIP ID # 36002), which are approximately 768 and 4,200 square feet, respectively, (the "Structures"), as shown on that Aerial attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Structures are identified by GFC to be demolished as they have been heavily vandalized, are beyond the ability to salvage or sell, and are a liability to GFC; and
- WHEREAS:** The State Board of the Georgia Forestry Commission recommended the demolition of the Structures and requested that the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structures as in the best interest of the State of Georgia is to utilize the site for timber purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** The Georgia Forestry Commission is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.

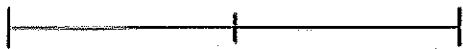
