**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND GROUNDS  
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

**WHEREAS:** Peach County Sheriff's Deputy Daryl Smallwood passed away on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, as a result of injuries sustained while responding to a call on Sunday, November 6; and

**WHEREAS:** Deputy Smallwood was a dedicated public servant who honorably served with the Dooly and Crisp County Sheriff's Offices before joining the Peach County Sheriff's Office; and

**WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize the sacrifice made by Deputy Smallwood, and to honor all of our law enforcement officers who put their lives on the line each day as they uphold their commitment to protect the communities and people they serve.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF DEPUTY DARYL SMALLWOOD, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and flag of the Great State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and grounds until sunset on Saturday, November 12, 2016, the day of his interment.
