EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: The Honorable John Meadows, District 5 Representative in the Georgia House of Representatives, passed away on November 13, 2018; and

WHEREAS: Rep. Meadows was a true public servant, as he served in the Georgia House of Representatives for 14 years and as Mayor of Calhoun for 13 years; and

WHEREAS: In addition to his dedicated service to the State of Georgia and the City of Calhoun, Rep. Meadows honorably served as a Marine in the United States Marine Corps; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to remember and honor Representative Meadows' service to our state and country.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND MEMORY OF THE HONORABLE JOHN MEADOWS, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds from Saturday, November 17, 2018, until sunset on Monday, November 19, 2018.
