FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN BUTTS COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: The Honorable Michael Allen "Mac" Collins passed away on Tuesday, November 20, 2018; and

WHEREAS: In addition to his 12 years of service in the U.S. House of Representatives, Congressman Collins served 4 years in the Georgia State Senate, and 6 years in the Georgia National Guard; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to remember and honor Congressman Mac Collins for his dedicated service to the state of Georgia and the United States of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF THE HONORABLE MICHAEL ALLEN "MAC" COLLINS, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and flag of the Great State of Georgia should be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Butts County beginning on Friday, November 23 and until sunset on Sunday, November 25, 2018.
