EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 20.97 acres of improved real property (the "Property"), known as the Walton Fish Hatchery, located in Walton County by virtue of a Warranty Deed dated June 19, 1958, from Henry Harvey Crawley, known also as H.H. Crawley and as Harvey H. Crawley, and Sally J. (Mrs. C.A.) Crawley being inventoried as record #001387 by the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") for recreation and conservation purposes; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with an Office Building (BLLIP ID # 12903) (the "Structure"), as shown on that Aerial attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS: Said Structure is identified by DNR to be demolished as it is obsolete to the needs of the department; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Board of Natural Resources recommended the demolition of the Structure and requested that the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structure as in the best interest of the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Department of Natural Resources is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.
