EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 89.44 acres of improved real property (the

"Property"), which is a portion of various tracts acquired for the Little Ocmulgee State Park,

Wheeler County; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Forestry Commission ("GFC") by way of

transfer from the Georgia Department of State Parks, as approved by the Governor on February 15, 1952 under Resolution Act Number 131 (H.R. No. 238-908g), and was acquired

for GFC's District Headquarters and to establish and maintain a demonstration forest; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with the McRae District Office (BLLIP ID # 36389), which is

approximately 1,728 square feet (the "Structure"), as shown on that aerial attached hereto

as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS: Said Structure is identified by GFC to be demolished as the office is obsolete and has

experienced significant fire damage and a new District Office will be constructed; and

WHEREAS: The State Board of the Georgia Forestry Commission recommended the demolition of the

Structure and requested that the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structure as in the best

interest of the State of Georgia in construction of the new District Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF

THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Forestry Commission is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing,

demolition and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to

be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.
