- WHEREAS:** On Thursday, November 30, 2017, Ms. Edna Umeh was tragically killed as she conducted her duties as a school crossing guard at Lindley Middle School; and
- WHEREAS:** Ms. Umeh proudly served the citizens of Cobb County and gave her life while ensuring the safe passage of students walking to school; and
- WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize the service Ms. Edna Umeh provided to the citizens of Cobb County and the State of Georgia.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF MS. EDNA UMEH, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**
