and over 5,000 will be diagnosed with the disease; and

WHEREAS:

Breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death for

women in the United States; and

WHEREAS:

The efforts of various organizations around Georgia have made major contributions to spreading breast cancer awareness to both women and men in all communities through outreach, education, and screening programs and have empowered women with the life-saving message of early detection as well as the

importance of having annual mammograms; and

WHEREAS:

Breast Cancer Prevention and Awareness Month is an opportunity to unite all citizens of Georgia in an effort to prevent breast cancer deaths through increased education and regular

screening; now

THEREFORE:

I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 2014 as BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH and urge all Georgia residents to join the fight against cancer.
