A PROCLAMATION BUY FROM GEORGIA MONTH

WHEREAS:

A strong manufacturing industry, locally and nationally, contributes to a

strong economy in Georgia and the United States; and

WHEREAS:

Manufacturers in Georgia account for 10.6 percent of the total output in the state, employing 9 percent of the workforce. There are nearly 9,500 manufacturing facilities in our state that provide more than 350,000 jobs;

and

WHEREAS:

The average compensation for manufacturing employees is 19 percent

higher than workers in other industries; and

WHEREAS:

The average Georgia consumer cannot identify three products that are manufactured in our state, and there is no formal time to highlight these products; and

WHEREAS:

Consumers generally prefer to buy locally manufactured goods and would benefit from heightened awareness about products that are made in Georgia; now

THEREFORE:

I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 2014 as BUY FROM GEORGIA MONTH and encourage our citizens to buy locally manufactured goods year-round.
