A PROCLAMATION

DAY OF THE COWBOY

- WHEREAS: The cowboy loves, lives off, and depends upon the land and is an excellent steward, dedicated to protecting and enhancing the environment; and
- WHEREAS: The cowboy is an American icon and continues to play a significant role in Georgia's culture and economy. Membership in rodeo and other organizations surrounding the work of the cowboy transcends ethnicity, gender, and age; and
- WHEREAS: To recognize the cowboy is to acknowledge America's ongoing commitment to an esteemed and enduring code of conduct. The contributions made by cowboys and cowgirls to their communities should be celebrated and encouraged; now
- THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 11, 2014, as the DAY OF THE COWBOY in Georgia and thank all the cowboys and cowgirls for their role in establishing and preserving this nation.
