WHEREAS: Dystonia affects an estimated 500,000 people in North America, a third of

which are children; and

WHEREAS: Numerous organizations, in the State of Georgia, are committed to

investing the proper resources so that we may find a cure for this non-degenerative disease. It is the hope of the dystonia community to lessen the physical, emotional, and financial burdens of this devastating disease;

THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

September 2015 as DYSTONIA AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia in order to

bring attention to this condition in our state.
