

House Bill 1048 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act creating the Houston County Commission on Children and Youth, approved
2 April 14, 1997 (Ga. L.1997, p. 4177); to provide for the assets and liabilities thereof; to
3 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 An Act creating the Houston County Commission on Children and Youth, approved April
7 14, 1997 (Ga. L.1997, p. 4177) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

8 **SECTION 2.**

9 There are no known assets of the Houston County Commission on Children and Youth, but
10 to the extent any assets of the Houston County Commission on Children and Youth exist,
11 they shall devolve automatically and without further action to Houston County, Georgia.
12 The Board of Commissioners of Houston County, Georgia, is authorized to execute any
13 deeds or instruments of conveyance required to place title of such assets into the name of
14 Houston County, and is authorized to do so in the name of the Houston County Commission
15 on Children and Youth. There are no known obligations of the Houston County Commission
16 on Children and Youth, but to the extent such obligations exist, they shall be transferred to
17 and assumed by Houston County, Georgia, by such instruments as may be required to
18 maintain the same. The Board of Commissioners of Houston County, Georgia, is authorized
19 to execute any such instruments required to transfer such obligations into the name of
20 Houston County, and is authorized to do so in the name of the Houston County Commission
21 on Children and Youth.

22 **SECTION 3.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
