A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to reincorporate and provide a new charter for the City of
2 Acworth," approved February 17, 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 3512), as amended, so as to adopt
3 by reference a certain map; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 An Act entitled "An Act to reincorporate and provide a new charter for the City of Acworth,"
7 approved February 17, 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 3512), as amended, is amended by revising
8 subsection (a) of Section 1.11 as follows:

9 "(a) The boundaries of this city shall be those existing on the effective date of this charter
10 with such alterations as may be made from time to time by local law or in a manner
11 provided by general state law. The boundaries of this city at all times shall be shown on
12 a map, a written description, or any combination thereof, to be retained permanently in the
13 office of the city clerk and to be designated, as the case may be, the 'Official Map or
14 Description of the Corporate Limits of the City of Acworth, Georgia.' Photographic, typed,
15 or other copies of such map or description certified by the city clerk shall be admitted as
16 evidence in all courts and shall have the same force and effect as the original map or
17 description. The 'Official Map of the Corporate Limits of the City of Acworth, Georgia,'
18 dated January 18, 2018, prepared by the city clerk of the City of Acworth is adopted as the
19 official map of the corporate limits of the City of Acworth, Georgia, and the corporate
20 boundaries of the city as of January 1, 2019, shall be reflected on such official map, subject
21 to amendment as set forth in this charter or by local Act of the General Assembly."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
