A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a new charter for the City of Sugar Hill, approved May 14, 2003  
2 (Ga. L. 2003, p. 3546), so as to change provisions relating to municipal property ownership;  
3 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 An Act creating a new charter for the City of Sugar Hill, approved May 14, 2003 (Ga. L.  
7 2003, p. 3546), is amended by revising paragraph (19) of Section 1.12 as follows:

8 "(19) Property ownership. To acquire, hold, sell, exchange, rent, lease, or otherwise  
9 acquire or dispose of any real, personal, or mixed property, in fee simple or lesser  
10 interest, whether held by the city in its proprietary, governmental, or other capacity,  
11 inside or outside of the corporate boundaries of the city and wherever located."

13 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
