

House Bill 1139 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to repeal and replace the Charter of the City of Fairmount, approved April
2 17, 1975 (Ga. L. 1975, p. 3136), as amended, so as to change the corporate limits of the city
3 by annexing certain territory to the city; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 An Act to repeal and replace the Charter of the City of Fairmount, approved April 17, 1975
8 (Ga. L. 1975, p. 3136), as amended, is amended in Section 1.11 by adding a new subsection
9 to read as follows:

10 "(a.1) In addition to all other territory contained in the city, the City of Fairmount shall
11 include all of the following described property:

12 (1) The right of way of United States Highway 411/State Highway 61, as such existed
13 on January 1, 2016, as it extends generally south from the southern boundary of the
14 corporate limits of the City of Fairmount to the Bartow County line; and

15 (2) The right of way of United States Highway 411/State Highway 61, as such existed
16 on January 1, 2016, as it extends generally north from the northern boundary of the
17 corporate limits of the City of Fairmount to the northerly right of way of Orr Mill Road."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
