

House Bill 282 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of commissioners for the County of Grady, approved
2 December 22, 1937 (Ga. L. 1937-38, Ex. Sess. p. 837), as amended, so as to change the
3 compensation of the board; to remove the board's authority to fix the salary of the
4 chairperson; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating a board of commissioners for the County of Grady, approved
9 December 22, 1937 (Ga. L. 1937-38, Ex. Sess. p. 837), as amended, is amended by striking
10 subsection (f) of Section 5 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

11 "(f) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this Section to the contrary, the board of
12 commissioners as a whole shall have the authority to define and limit the duties to be
13 performed by the chairperson of the board."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 Said Act is further amended by striking Section 8 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16 "SECTION 8.

17 (a) The chairperson of the board of commissioners shall receive 17 percent of the base
18 salary of the Clerk of Superior Court of Grady County as compensation to be paid from
19 county funds.

20 (b) All other members of the board of commissioners shall receive 12 percent of the base
21 salary of the Clerk of Superior Court of Grady County as compensation to be paid from
22 county funds; provided, however, that any such member who has been designated as a
23 certified county commissioner pursuant to Code Section 36-5-27 of the Official Code of

24 Georgia Annotated shall receive an additional \$100.00 per month in accordance with such
25 Code section as compensation to be paid from county funds."

26 **SECTION 3.**

27 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
28 it is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval.

29 **SECTION 4.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
