

House Bill 394 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Oxford, approved April 13, 2001
2 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4195), as amended, so as to change the corporate limits of such municipality;
3 to provide for related matters; to provide for a contingent effective date; to repeal conflicting
4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Oxford, approved April 13, 2001
8 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4195), as amended, is amended by adding a new subsection (c) to
9 Section 1.11 to read as follows:

10 "(c) In addition to the area now included in the corporate limits of the City of Oxford, the
11 following area shall be included in the corporate limits of such municipality:

12 All that tract or parcel of land lying and being in Land Lot 267 of the 9th Land District,
13 Newton County, Georgia, and being more particularly described as follows:

14 Beginning at a point on the Land Lot line dividing Land Lot 267 and Land Lot 270
15 (said line also being the city limits of the City of Oxford) at its intersection with the
16 western right of way of Emory Street (50' ROW), also known as Georgia Highway 81,
17 and being the Point of Beginning; thence, running westerly along said land lot line a
18 distance of 184 feet to a point; thence, running south a distance of 130 feet to a point;
19 thence, running east a distance of 110 feet to a point on the northerly right of way of
20 Geiger Street (50' ROW); thence, running northeasterly along the northerly right of way
21 of Geiger Street a distance of 110 feet to a point marking the intersection of Geiger
22 Street and Emory Street; thence, running north along the westerly right of way of
23 Emory Street a distance of 65 feet to the Point of Beginning.

24 Said property being now or formerly known as 6153 and 6155 N. Emory Street,
25 Covington, Georgia 30014, and in accordance with the current system of numbering
26 houses in Newton County, Georgia."

SECTION 2.

28 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
29 it is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval, provided that an Act
30 deannexing the territory described in this Act from the City of Covington is enacted in the
31 2017 session of the General Assembly.

SECTION 3.

33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
