A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act creating the Chatham-Savannah Youth Futures Authority, approved  
2 March 10, 1988 (Ga. L.1988, p. 3743), as amended; to provide for the assets and liabilities  
3 thereof; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws;  
4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating the Chatham-Savannah Youth Futures Authority, approved March 10, 1988  
8 (Ga. L.1988, p. 3743), as amended, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

9 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

10 There are no known assets of the Chatham-Savannah Youth Futures Authority, but to the  
11 extent any assets of the Chatham-Savannah Youth Futures Authority exist, they shall devolve  
12 automatically and without further action to Chatham County, Georgia. The Board of  
13 Commissioners of Chatham County, Georgia, is authorized to execute any deeds or  
14 instruments of conveyance required to place title of such assets into the name of Chatham  
15 County and is authorized to do so in the name of the Chatham-Savannah Youth Futures  
16 Authority. There are no known obligations of the Chatham-Savannah Youth Futures  
17 Authority, but to the extent such obligations exist, they shall be transferred to and assumed  
18 by Chatham County, Georgia, by such instruments as may be required to maintain the same.  
19 The Board of Commissioners of Chatham County, Georgia, is authorized to execute any such  
20 instruments required to transfer such obligations into the name of Chatham County and is  
21 authorized to do so in the name of the Chatham-Savannah Youth Futures Authority.

23 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2017.
