

House Bill 1063 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to incorporate the City of South Fulton in Fulton County, Georgia,
2 approved April 26, 2016 (Ga. L. 2016, p. 3726), as amended, so as to limit the authority of
3 the mayor and city council over personnel matters; to provide for related matters; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act to incorporate the City of South Fulton in Fulton County, Georgia, approved April
8 26, 2016 (Ga. L. 2016, p. 3726), is amended by revising paragraph (1) of Section 3.25 as
9 follows:

10 "(1) Have the authority to hire persons to act as department heads or directors and fill
11 other positions designated by ordinance or resolution and appoint and, when the city
12 manager deems it necessary for the good of the city, suspend or remove any city
13 employees and administrative officers the city manager hires or appoints, except as
14 otherwise provided by law. The city manager may authorize any administrative officer
15 who is subject to the city manager's direction and supervision to exercise these powers
16 with respect to subordinates in that officer's department, office, or agency;"

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 Said Act is further amended in subsection (c) of Section 7.16 by deleting paragraph (8) and
19 designating such paragraph as reserved.

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
