A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend an Act to provide for a homestead exemption from City of Villa Rica ad valorem
taxes for municipal purposes in the amount of \$8,000.00 of the assessed value of the
homestead for residents of that city who are 65 years of age or older, approved February 20,
2017 (Act No. 6), so as to change the date of a referendum; to repeal conflicting laws; and
for other purposes.

SECTION 1.

8 An Act providing for a homestead exemption from City of Villa Rica ad valorem taxes for 9 municipal purposes in the amount of \$8,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for 10 residents of that city who are 65 years of age or older, approved February 20, 2017 (Act 11 No. 6), is amended by revising Section 2 as follows:

"SECTION 2.

13 The municipal election superintendent of the City of Villa Rica shall call and conduct an 14 election as provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the City of Villa Rica for approval or rejection. The municipal election superintendent shall 15 16 conduct that election on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 2017, and shall issue the call and conduct that election as provided by general law. The municipal 17 18 superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week 19 for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organs of Carroll County 20 and Douglas County. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:

"() YES Shall the Act be approved which provides a homestead exemption from City
of Villa Rica ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in the amount of
() NO \$8,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for residents of that city
who are 65 years of age or older?"

25 All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on 26 27 such question are for approval of the Act, Section 1 of this Act shall become of full force and effect on January 1, 2018. If the Act is not so approved or if the election is not conducted 28 as provided in this section, Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective and this Act shall 29 be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately following that election 30 date. The expense of such election shall be borne by the City of Villa Rica. It shall be the 31 32 municipal election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the Secretary of State."

SECTION 2.

34 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
