## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act providing that the governing authority of each county comprising the
- 2 Waycross Judicial Circuit may supplement the compensation, salary, expenses, and
- 3 allowances of each of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit,
- 4 approved March 20, 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 3879), so as to increase the amounts of such
- 5 supplements; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 6 laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 An Act providing that the governing authority of each county comprising the Waycross
- 10 Judicial Circuit may supplement the compensation, salary, expenses, and allowances of each
- of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit, approved March 20,
- 12 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 3879), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:
- 13 **"Section 1.** In addition to the compensation, salary, expenses, and allowances presently
- being received by the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit from
- 15 the State of Georgia or from any other source, the governing authority of each county
- 16 comprising the Waycross Judicial Circuit shall supplement the compensation, salary,
- expenses, and allowances of each of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross
- Judicial Circuit. The division of payment among the six counties shall not be less than the
- 19 following amounts for each judge:

21	Brantley	550.00 per month
22	Charlton	450.00 per month
23	Coffee	700.00 per month
24	Pierce	550.00 per month
