A PROCLAMATION NATIONAL DAY OF SERVICE

- WHEREAS: October 11, 2015, marks the 125th anniversary of the founding of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution to honor the memory and spirit of the men and women who helped to achieve American independence; and
- WHEREAS: The Archibald Bulloch Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution was founded in 1963 in Statesboro to help serve their community on a local level; and
- WHEREAS: Organizations like Daughters of the American Revolution promote historic preservation, education, and patriotism; and
- WHEREAS: The Daughters are celebrating their founding and providing 10 million hours of service to America. The Archibald Bulloch Chapter is honoring this day by donating a park bench to Rockwell Park in Edgewood; and
- WHEREAS: Service and hospitality are hallmarks of the culture and heritage of Georgia. These values are exemplified and furthered by the "National Day of Service;" now
- THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 11, 2015, as NATIONAL DAY OF SERVICE in Georgia.
