WHEREAS: More qualified RNs are needed to meet the increasingly complex needs of

consumers; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Nurses Association is diligently working to chart a new course for a

healthier Georgia by increasing the delivery of primary health care and renewing an emphasis on primary and preventive health care, better utilizing

our state's RN resources; and

WHEREAS: Today, we celebrate the past accomplishments of groups like the Georgia
