A PROCLAMATION

PAYROLL WEEK

WHEREAS: The American Payroll Association and its 23,000 members have launched a

nationwide public awareness campaign that pays tribute to the more than 160 million people who work in the United States and the payroll professionals who support the American system by paying wages, reporting worker earnings, and

withholding federal employment taxes; and

WHEREAS: National Payroll Week is designed to help workers in America better understand

issues related to the payroll and tax systems, as well as to educate payroll professionals and employers about important payroll-related regulatory and

compliance issues; and

WHEREAS: Payroll professionals in Georgia play a key role in maintaining our state's economic

health, carrying out such diverse tasks as paying into the unemployment insurance system, providing information for child support enforcement, and carrying out tax

withholding, reporting, and depositing; and

WHEREAS: Payroll departments nationwide spend more than \$16 billion annually, complying

with a myriad of federal, state, and local wage tax laws. These funds support important civic projects, including roads, schools, and parks in communities across

Georgia; and

WHEREAS: These dedicated professionals continually strive to meet the highest standards while

improving compliance with government procedures, reducing costs, and improving

the overall payroll process in Georgia; now

THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September

7-11, 2015, as PAYROLL WEEK in Georgia.
