- WHEREAS: The prevention, control, and elimination of destructive insects, rodents, and other pests from homes, factories, food establishments, and other properties is vital to the health of all our citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Many areas are highly susceptible to pests that present health and safety hazards to citizens, businesses, and their properties; and
- WHEREAS: Through effective and responsible pest control practices, members of the pest control industry make our communities, homes, and workplaces free of the disease and destruction caused by insects, rodents, and other invaders; and
- WHEREAS: It is fitting and appropriate to recognize the Georgia Pest Control Association for its efforts to ensure the safe and proper use of pesticides and to protect our environment and residents; now
- THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 2014 as PEST CONTROL MONTH in Georgia.
