A PROCLAMATION

RANGER HOTLINE DAY

WHEREAS: The Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR) was established to manage

and protect the state's diverse natural resources and is charged with managing, protecting, and encouraging the conservation of all wildlife, including game and

nongame animals, fish, and protected plants; and

WHEREAS: Ownership of all wildlife is by the State of Georgia, held in trust for all of its

citizens. A poacher is one who takes wildlife illegally and, as such, is a thief who

steals from all Georgians; and

WHEREAS: The Ranger Hotline Program was established as an initiative of the Georgia Natural

Resources Foundation, a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving and protecting Georgia's natural, cultural, and historical resources for current and

future generations; and

WHEREAS: The Ranger Hotline Program enhances the effectiveness of the Georgia's Law

Enforcement Division Conservation Rangers by encouraging citizen involvement in the detection and reporting of game and fish violations. The hotline program provides monetary rewards for information that leads to the arrest of poachers;

and

WHEREAS: The Ranger Hotline Program is supported by donations from sportsmen and

women, wildlife organizations, and all concerned citizens; and

WHEREAS: The Ranger Hotline Program encourages support of the local judicial system in the

stringent enforcement of game and fish laws as well as all DNR infractions; now

THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October

18, 2014, as RANGER HOTLINE DAY in Georgia.
