to school staff members, family members, and community stakeholders on topics that impact students' ability to learn. They empower and assist

families in accessing resources to improve their circumstance; and

WHEREAS: School Social Work Week honors those who are committed to ensuring that

our young people receive the most out of their educational opportunities

by overcoming barriers to learning; now
