## A PROCLAMATION WE CARD AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS:

Georgia law prohibits the sale of tobacco products to persons under the

age of 18; and

WHEREAS:

We Card Awareness Month is a retail education and training effort to boost retailers' awareness of and participation in responsible retailing efforts to comply with federal, state, and local laws as well as identify, prevent, and deny tobacco and other age-restricted product sales to minors; and

WHEREAS:

This year marks the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the national non-profit organization, the "We Card" Program, Inc., which provides training and education to the retail community to help retailers comply with age; and

WHEREAS:

We Card is endorsed by the Georgia Association of Convenience Stores. We Card in-store training and education materials, online training program, and mystery shopping service, "ID Check-Up," are available to all Georgia retailers through the We Card website. Our state will benefit from a responsible retailing community that successfully prevents tobacco and other age-restricted product sales to minors; and

WHEREAS:

The State of Georgia benefits from a responsible retailing community that successfully prevents tobacco and other age-restricted product sales to minors as it promotes healthier lifestyles for our young people and makes our state a safer place to call home; now
