




REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR

DONALD K. BALFOUR, II

In accordance with Georgia Constitution, Article II, Section III, Paragraph I, the Review Commission appointed by the Governor to make certain determinations regarding Superior Court of Fulton County, Atlanta Judicial Circuit indictment number 13SC 121767 against Georgia State Senator Donald K. Balfour, II, convened and had a hearing on November 13, 2013.

After hearing from interested parties and reviewing the indictment, the Commission determines that the indictment against Senator Balfour DOES relate to and adversely affects the administration of the office of the indicted public official and that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby.



EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: By Executive Order dated October 15, 2013, a review commission was appointed to determine whether the indictment of the Senator representing District 9 in the Georgia State Senate, Donald K. Balfour, II, related to and adversely impacts the administration of the office of State Senator pursuant to Article 2, Section 3, Paragraph 1 of the Georgia Constitution; and

WHEREAS: By the report dated November 13, 2013, that commission determined that State Senator Donald K. Balfour, II, be suspended from office under the provisions of Ga. Const. Art. 2, § 3, ¶ 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Donald K. Balfour, II is hereby suspended from office immediately as provided for in Ga. Const. Art. 2, § 3, ¶ 1(b) & (h).
