A PROCLAMATION ADOPTION AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS: Every child deserves to grow up in a loving and nurturing family, with adults to help

guide each child to a happy and productive life; and

WHEREAS: Each November, foster care and adoption entities across the nation implement

programs and initiatives to build awareness regarding the thousands of children

who are in foster care and waiting to be adopted; and

WHEREAS: On behalf of the children under the care of the Georgia Division of Family and

Children Services (DFCS), the State of Georgia is committed to educating all citizens

about the need for adoptive parents statewide; and

WHEREAS: On March 5, 2018, I signed HB 159 into law. This legislation enacted comprehensive

reforms to Georgia's adoption code to make it easier for adoptive parents to create

a loving family; and

WHEREAS: DFCS, in conjunction with Adoption Awareness Month, is sponsoring a month-long

initiative to generate awareness about the children who need "Forever Families," and to recruit adoptive parents for the children eligible for adoption in Georgia's foster

care system; and

WHEREAS: By providing safe and nurturing environments for children, we can ensure that they

will grow to their full potential as the next generation of Georgia's leaders that will

help to secure the future of our state and nation; now

THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November

2018 as ADOPTION AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia.
