A PROCLAMATION ADOPTION DAY

WHEREAS: Every child deserves to grow up in a loving and nurturing family, with adults to help

guide each child to a happy and productive life; and

WHEREAS: Each November, foster care and adoption entities across the nation implement activities,

programs, and initiatives to build awareness regarding the thousands of children who

are in the foster care system waiting to be adopted; and

WHEREAS: On March 5, 2018, I signed HB 159 into law. This legislation enacted comprehensive

reforms to Georgia's adoption code to make it easier for adoptive parents to create a

loving family; and

WHEREAS: Adoption Day brings together partners in the legal community to finalize adoptions and

find permanent homes for children in foster care; and

WHEREAS: On Adoption Day and throughout Adoption Awareness Month, communities across the

state come together to celebrate families who adopt and provide loving, caring, and

supportive homes for children; and

WHEREAS: In conjunction with Adoption Awareness Month, the Fulton County Juvenile Court will

host its 17th Adoption Day Celebration on November 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS: By providing safe and nurturing environments for children, we can ensure that they will

grow to their full potential as the next generation of Georgia's leaders that will help to

secure the future of our state and nation; now

THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 2018

as ADOPTION AWARENESS MONTH and November 17, 2018, as ADOPTION DAY in

Georgia.

eighteen.
