- WHEREAS: Data collected by cancer registrars includes patient demographics, anatomic cancer sites, stages of diseases, treatments, and lifetime follow-ups. This data is also valuable to epidemiologists as they determine the cancer burden throughout Georgia and the nation; and
- WHEREAS: Cancer registrars throughout our state are committed to promoting the latest medical advances in the diagnosis and treatment of this devastating disease; and
- WHEREAS: Cancer Registrars Week recognizes the contributions and advances that professional cancer registrars make in the field of allied health across our state; now
- THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 9-13, 2018, as CANCER REGISTRARS WEEK in Georgia.
