people do not know that it is within their power to give someone else the ability

to see; and

Eye donation for research has the potential to restore sight for those suffering WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: To date, more than 44,000 Georgians have received the gift of sight from an

eye donor; and

WHEREAS: Eye donation for corneal transplantation can restore useful vision to those who

have corneal blindness. Approximately 1,600 sight-restoring cornea

transplants are performed in Georgia every year; and

WHEREAS: Eye Donation Month provides an opportunity to raise awareness regarding

opportunities to give the gift of sight; and

WHEREAS: Eye donation is one of the most selfless gifts one can provide to a fellow citizen,

and it is vitally important to discuss organ donation with loved ones and family;
